How to obtain a negative PCR test certificate

- 1 The airline company boarding the flight to Japan provides a fee-based kit, and the individual carries out the test themselves at home/hotel, sends it in and obtains a certificate.
- 2 Obtained in Hiroshima city.

Tests are conducted at a hospital for a fee.

PCR testing

1 Hiroshima Prefecture: free testing.

Hiroshima Prefecture offers free PCR testing.

Out-of-prefecture (including overseas) visitors to Hiroshima can also take the test, but a negative certificate cannot be issued here because the doctor does not carry out the PCR test. Advance booking is required.

If there is space available, it will also accept people who have not made a reservation. (If no space is available, test kits will be distributed.)

2 Whether negative proof of PCR testing is required at the departure from the country (from ANAWEB).

Depending on the country of entry (return), a negative certificate may or may not be required.

3 Hiroshima airport and other airports: antigen testing for a fee.

Antigen testing (30 minutes to reveal) can be reserved/conducted at Hiroshima Airport.

The PCR test results will be available the next day.

Flight boarding (from ANAWEB)

This is optional, but if you wish, you must be tested beforehand.

If you do not take the test, you can still board the aircraft.
